



**Gibraltar FA**  
**Parents and Code of Conduct 2022**

1. Help create a positive and enjoyable learning environment for the children, being a role model for your children with your conduct and behaviour.
2. Parents or guardians must not coach from the touchline during matches. Any form of verbal / physical abuse to the players, coaches, referees, delegates, and security is not allowed. Parents who abuse this rule will be asked to leave the premises.
3. Never vocally dispute a referee's decision.
4. Parents/Guardians must not enter the field of play without consent.
5. Avoid pressurising your child about winning or losing. Remember that the GFA take a long-term approach to your child's football development.
6. Do not photograph or video the players without permission. Only club official team photographers will be allowed to photograph and video players. This rule is in line with the child protection policies and procedures of the Gibraltar FA.

All parents and spectators must abide by the Gibraltar FA Code of Conduct. As parents and guardians, we all have a responsibility to help our children. On behalf of the Gibraltar FA, we appreciate your co-operation and support and through this we will improve junior football in Gibraltar.

Disciplinary actions by steps:

1. Verbal warning by GFA Delegate or Security
2. Asked to leave the premises by a GFA delegate or Security
3. Police intervention

Any breaches to this code of conduct will be dealt with under the Gibraltar Football Association disciplinary regulations in place at the time (this may include disciplinary action taken upon the club to whom the participant or supporter belongs to).
