Regular season (starting on 12 th August 2019)	
•	14 teams in one single division.
•	Each team plays against all other teams once (Rounds 1-13).
•	Top 7 teams split into "Championship Group".
•	Bottom 7 teams split into "Challenge Group".
•	The points gained by all teams during the first 13 rounds are preserved and carried through to the group stages.
•	Each team then plays against all teams twice (Rounds 14-25).
•	Each team will therefore play a total of 25 league matches in the season.

The "Championship Group".

- The winner of the Championship Group is declared the Champion and will participate in the following season's UEFA Champions League.
- The runner-up of the Championship Group will participate in the following season's UEFA Europa League.
- Depending on who the winner of the Gibtelecom Cup is, the third-placed team in the Championship Group could also qualify for the following season's UEFA Europa League.

The "Challenge Group".

• The winner of the Challenge Group will receive the GFA Challenge Trophy at the end of each season.

Gibtelecom Cup.

Season 2019/20

- A total of <u>fifteen</u> teams will participate in the 2019/20 Gibtelecom Cup, comprised of the fourteen National League teams plus FC Hound Dogs from the Intermediate League.
- The 2018/19 Gibtelecom Cup winners, Europa FC, will be given an automatic bye to the Quarter Finals.
- The following fourteen teams will therefore participate in the draw for the First Round of the 2019/20 Gibtelecom Cup:
 - Lincoln Red Imps FC
 - o St. Joseph's FC
 - o Mons Calpe SC
 - o Lynx FC
 - o Glacis United FC
 - o Lions Gibraltar FC
 - o FC Boca Juniors (Gibraltar)
 - o FCB Mapgpies
 - o Europa Point FC
 - o FC Olympique Gibraltar 13
 - o Manchester 62 FC
 - o College 1975 FC
 - o Leo FC
 - o FC Hound Dogs
- The fourteen teams will be drawn into seven First Round matches.
- The following eight teams will then participate in the draw for the Quarter Finals of the Gibtelecom Cup:
 - Europa FC
 - 7 x First Round winners
- The competition would then progress normally to two Semi Finals and a Final.

Season 2020/21

Provisionally, the 2020/21 Gibtelecom Cup will follow the same format as the 2019/20 Gibtelecom Cup.

Other conditions.

- For Season 2019/20, the HGP quota will be increased to 4 (a minimum of four HGPs on the field of play at all times).
- For Season 2020/21, the HGP quota will be increased to 5 (a minimum of five HGPs on the field of play at all times).
- The new league structure will be closely monitored with a view to a full reassessment in June 2022.
- The HGP quota will be closely monitored with a view to a full reassessment in June 2022.
- The Intermediate League (a development league for U23 players) is maintained for 2019/20 and will be reassessed in June 2020.
- Global goal difference will be replaced by head-to-head records in cases where two or more teams are level on points.
- Prize monies will continue to be awarded to teams according to their final positions.
- Prize monies will not be awarded to teams who qualify for the UEFA Champions League or UEFA Europa League by virtue of their final league position.
